WORDNET ANNOTATION FOR NOUNS

Head node: <n>

Attribute: <sense>

Possible values for the attribute **<sense>** correspond to the encoding of the synset for each lexical item: two numbers indicating WordNet version (currently 1.6 –encoded as 16), followed by a dot and 8 more numbers (the offset of the synset), and, finally, a letter which indicates the type of PoS (n –noun–, v –verb–, a –adjective–, r –adverb–). For instance:

sense = "16.05443572n" corresponds to the nominal synset 05443572n in WordNet 1.6.

Apart from these specific labels, there are seven generic values for the attribute covering a variety of cases:

- cs1: "The word exists in dictionary, but not its sense"
- cs2: "The word does not exist in dictionary"
- cs3: "The word is part of a Multiword Lexical Unit or a lexicalized inflected form"
- cs4: "The word is part of a Named Entity"
- cs5: "The tagger is strongly uncertain"
- cs6: "The word was improperly lemmatized or PoS-Tagged"
- cs7: "The word is wrongly used: misspelling or a loanword"
